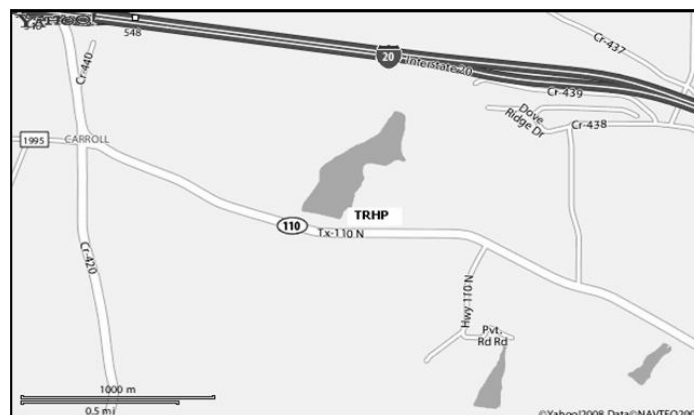

Guidelines

Entries: Email entries to Melissa Osburn at melissa.osburn@yahoo.com. Entries are due by October 25, 2017. Please include: name of horse and rider, class numbers, telephone number, number of stalls & shavings, any barn affiliation, **copy** of current Coggins.

Class fees: \$15 per class

All Hunter Derby fee: \$45

Jumper Classics Fee: \$25.00

Stall fees: \$75

Shavings: \$9/bag-3 bag minimum

Fees: Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$5 per day. An EMT will be on grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$5 office/\$5 scholarship fee will be charged at \$10 per entry. An open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. Nonmembers of NTHJC will be charged a \$20 fee.

NTHJC memberships can be paid at the show or online at nthjc.com.

NTHJC Thoroughbred High Point Hunter & Jumper Awards: Entry is free. TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry forms available in show office. An entry form must be filled out at each NTHJC show. Champion ribbon will be awarded and year end points will be accrued.

Coggins: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a **Copy of the Original Coggins test** which may be emailed with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival.

Stalls: Stalls are 12'x12' permanent box stalls and will be available noon Friday through Sunday. A \$35 grounds fee will be charged for any horse without a stall. No outside shavings are allowed. A 3 bag minimum is required.

RV Space, golf cart rental, and feed orders: Forms are on website - www.texasrosehorsepark.com and must be completed and mailed in with payment.

Arenas: Triple M 164' x 280', Hampton 120' x 240', RWB 180' x 300' all weather sand footing.

Schooling: There will be open schooling Friday from 2:00pm until 7:00pm. Open schooling will be available Saturday & Sunday mornings from 6:30am until times stated on schedule. There will be 15 minutes restricted to Limit riders. No jumper or Derby schooling.

Medal Classes: Are open only to NTHJC members. 1st & 2nd place winners will qualify for the Medal Finals held at the NTHJC Year End Show. Once a rider wins the class twice they may not enter again until the Finals.

Limit Divisions: Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 6 blue ribbons over fences. After winning six (6) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Once a rider has been awarded their Limit Out Certificate they must move out of the division. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at this show.

Cross Entries: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles may only cross enter in Walk Trot Crossrails. Walk Trot Crossrails may only cross enter into Limit Beginner 18".

Awards: All classes receive a first place Cash Prize (\$10 1st place) and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Reserve Champion ribbon as well as Cash Prize (\$15 Champion, \$5 Reserve) will be awarded for each division.

Attire: Proper show attire is required. Polo shirts with collars are allowed in jumper classes only. No chaps allowed.

Helmets: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn **at all times by all riders when mounted** anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

Warning: Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil, Practice & Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

Management: Reserves the right to change, cancel, move or combine classes and do all things necessary in the best interests of the horse show and its operations.

Concessions: Available during show hours Saturday & Sunday.

Split Classes: All classes, except warm-ups, with 20 or more entries will be split.

Duct tape and trash bag contest rules:

1. All of the costume must be made with duct tape and/or trash bags. All packaging from trash bags or duct tape can be used. Such as the cardboard roll from the duct tape etc...
2. You may have some under lining of cloth to protect your skin if you wish to. But underlining cannot be visible when wearing the costume.
3. Footwear or hats had to be made from duct tape or trash bags. Any stuffing or objects held in hands must be duct tape or trashbags.
4. Any color of duct tape or trash bags may be used.
5. You can have multiple people come out at one time but will be judged as one.
6. Keep it PG13.

Judges looking for:

1. Is all of the costume made with duct tape and trash bags? You will be counted off for anything that is not and is visible.
2. Detail
3. Actions or playing the part put on a show
4. Originality
