SEE SPOT RUN: DOG AGILITY TRIALS SET FOR FEBRUARY 25-26 AT TEXAS ROSE HORSE PARK

TYLER, TX, JANUARY 16, 2012: Tyler Obedience Training Club is sponsoring a United States Dog Agility Association (USDAA) Agility Trial at Texas Rose Horse Park Saturday & Sunday February 25-26, 2012. Over 100 dogs from five states will compete at various levels of difficulty against each other and the clock for prizes and titles around, over and through several kinds of obstacles. Many of these competitors will have competed & won at National competitions and have been seen on televised programs such as Animal Planet®. Spectators are welcomed to attend and admission is free. Please leave your dogs comfortably at home. Competition begins at 8:15 AM and lasts through mid-afternoon each day.

Agility is a competitive team sport comprised of a handler and her or his dog. The object of agility is for the handler to navigate the dog through a timed obstacle course without the dog making a mistake. The agility course is comprised of jumps, weave poles, tunnels and climbing equipment. Agility rules focus on safety for the dog. The sport of agility combines control, training and drive into a challenging game for both the handler and the dog.
